## Cost of living survey

- Master wishes to work with MCR to determine a general framework for providing support
- Master suggested survey to determine an annual income which would be defined as the minimum, e.g. 16k, college would provide funding to those falling below this threshold automatically
- 65 responses to survey, roughly $\sim 50 \%$ PhD respondents
- Praharsh has spoken to Peter Wothers about additional funding for medics to meet course costs like purchase of stethoscopes and textbooks

- College will match MCR expenditure 1:1
- Work to be carried out over the Long Vacation
- Substance of proposal
- dining table in place of bay tables
- addition of lounge area to upper room
- two separate seating areas in the lower room
- addition of cabinet to corridor
- new furniture
- replacement of lighting
- Voting issues:
- one large dining table vs. two smaller tables (or an extensible table?), eight ayes, one no
- armchairs vs. sofas; current proposal is for two extra armchairs over one extra sofa, seven in favour, two against
- colour schemes: restore original wood vs. rookwood dark green vs. all white
- restore panelling vs. colour scheme: panelling, unanimously
- rookwood dark green scheme as back-up if panelling cannot be restored
- Sound system: Bose (2) Sonos (4) Abstain (3); No option got more than 50\% of the vote
- Need a re-vote at the next meeting on the sound system after more information is provided. (Tobia to provide more info).
- Discussion about the bay windows in the lower room.
- Seating space in the bay windows in the lower room will be extended for more comfortable seating
- One bay window will be "closed" to turn into "coffeetable"
